

Fairport Girls Track & Field 43-0 in league competition!

On Monday, May 17th at the conclusion of the last league meet of the 2010 season, Fairport had defeated Webster Schroeder, 104 to 37 to extend its undefeated streak in Monroe County Division I competition to 43-0, over eight years. In 2002, Fairport lost to Webster for its last league loss.

The very strong events for Fairport were the 100m hurdles, a sweep by Emily Renna, Janessa Mathews and Michelle Barnum; the 400m hurdles, which included Barnum, Rachel Brekovsky and Angie Zabloutny also swept the top-three places. The 3000m with Gwen Hoffman, Carlie Gutzmer and Kathryn Ritzmann also swept as did the high jumpers, Lauren Burke, Amanda Burkey and Tylyn Martin.

Other events that were very strong for Fairport, taking the top two places, were the Triple jump with Renna and Burkey and the Long Jump with Renna and Mathews.

The 100m and 200m dashes with Lauren Burke and Julia Sanger had Fairport taking a 1st and 3rd in each. Erin Sedita won the 1500m with Lauren Star and Emma Dustman taking a 2nd and 3rd in the 800m. Rachel Brekovsky and Angie Zabloutny finished 2nd and 3rd in the 400m dash. And Renee Metzger won the shot put as did Amanda Burkey the pole vault.

Fairport won all three relays: the 4 x 100m included Renna, Sanger, Casey Slabe and Lauren Burke; the 4 x 400m relay had Ally Martens, Michelle Barnum, Erin Sedita and Lauren Star while the 4 x 800m relay was composed of Janessa Mathews, Emma Dustman, Mary O'Hehir and Angie Zabloutny.
